2021: 4th ERSO Show Contest, 04.12.2021, Mechelen/Belgium,
2nd ERSO Wheel Contest, 05.12.2021, Mechelen/Belgium,



2022: The European Rope Skipping Championships event, combining the 21st European Team Championships with the 14th European Individual Championships, was held from 23.-31.07.2022 in Bratislava/Slovakia. In total 505 athletes from 13 countries competed in the European Open Tournament, the Junior European Championships and the European Championships.

2. Discuss major accomplishments/ programs /events/ highlights for the past year,

In 2022 we were able to hold the first **EUROPE** Start-to-Coach course, 27.-29.05.2022, Kisakallio/Finland, participants from Finland and Estonia. Some more to follow end of 2022



3. Going forward discuss your biggest concerns for your Confederation.

The participation in the EC was very good and might be even higher in the future. This will create problems in event/competition length and needed volunteers to run the competition professionally, without burning out much needed individuals. In addition, the quality of the judges needs to raise equally with the quality of the athletes. This is nearly impossible with the current judging system, leaving behind frustrated athletes (not being awarded the correct difficulty of their routines) and judges (knowing that they did their best, that wasn't enough).

We have to be very careful in which direction we move with our rules. We have to urgently do something for not losing athletes/coaches/judges, but to move in the right direction.
